

# Information about LTG Sweden's processing of personal data

LTG Sweden AB (former Mobitec) – a part of Luminator Technology Group – is a global company in design and manufacturing of passenger information systems for public transport.

On 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018 the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into effect and replaces for instance Sweden's former PUL law (Personal data act). The Regulation protects fundamental rights and freedoms of natural persons and in particular their right to the protection and control of personal data.

For LTG Sweden this means increased requirements of how we process and use personal data. You are always welcome to contact us if you want information about how your personal data is used (contact information at the bottom of this document).

## What is personal data?

According to the Regulation personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (data subject) who can be directly or indirectly identified by reference to such as an identification number, name, address, photos, e-mail address etc.

## What do we mean by processing?

Processing of personal data is basically everything that can be done with them, such as gather, register, store them or print the data.

## Which personal data we process and for what reason

In order to make contact with customers, suppliers and other interested parties it is required that LTG Sweden stores and processes personal data (mainly no sensitive data) and only to the necessary extent. Therefore, we urge you to only submit the relevant and requested data.

We at LTG Sweden AB like to inform that your personal information, such as name and email account, is only used in purpose to log in, use our cloud based services and reset passwords. Continued use means approval and acceptance of these terms and conditions.

## Lawfulness of processing of personal data

LTG Sweden has lawful grounds to process personal data, see also above. A justified interest means that we make a consideration of interest between the use of the processing and the risk for individuals' personal integrity. In GDPR, article 6, this is described and the following paragraphs are applicable to our activities:

- The data subject has given consent to the processing of his/her personal data for one or more specific purposes.
- Processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract.
- Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject
- Processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person.
- Processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data.

The exception for consideration of interest (the Regulation, article 6) is designed to make it possible to handle certain information without consent, as long as there is cause for "justified interest". Not sensitive data are for instance, name, address, phone number and e-mail address.

Besides the GDPR Regulation there are other legal obligations which makes it necessary to process and store personal data, such as the Swedish Bookkeeping Act.

The outset is that your personal data is only processed by LTG Sweden.

#### [How long do we save your personal data?](#)

We do not process and store your personal data for a longer period than what is necessary or allowed according to applicable law, regulation or authority decisions.

#### [Your rights](#)

You have a number of rights according to the Regulation, where you have the right to all information about when and how your personal data is processed and that you shall be able to control them.
